


# VISIT HISTORIC ST. PETER'S CHURCH



## OPEN DOWNTOWN DURING NATIONAL FOLK FESTIVAL



115 St. Peter's St., Between Main and Church Sts.

### HISTORY

St. Peter's Episcopal Church has been a downtown church for 251 years, beginning as a colonial chapel of ease. The current church brick structure was built in 1887 by renowned Philadelphia architect Charles Burns in the Italian Romanesque style. With more than 50 stained glass windows, a handpainted triptych above the altar and a newly installed custom built Walker organ, St. Peter's is one of the most beautiful sacred spaces on Maryland's Eastern Shore and is worth a visit while you are in Salisbury (see map on reverse).

### TOUR THE CHURCH

Located within the National Folk Festival area in downtown Salisbury, St. Peter's will be open for touring Friday evening, Saturday afternoon and evening and Sunday afternoon, during the hours of the Festival. All are welcome to see the interior of the church and learn about its history and architecture. Enter on the St. Peter's St. or Church St. Entrances. No charge.

### LISTEN TO AN ORGAN DEMONSTRATION

Demonstrations of St. Peter's organ which was built specifically for the space and for traditional Anglican singing will take place at St. Peter's throughout the Festival. Come hear St. Peter's organist Daniel Cherrix play a 10 minute demonstration of the organ and provide information about the organ and organ music. All are free and open to the public.


