## Flowers placed on the altar are a great way to:

- ✓ Celebrate a major event such as a birthday, anniversary, or baptism
- ✓ Honor a loved one who has passed with their favorite flowers
- ✓ Celebrate family and friends
- ✓ Give thanks for the glory of God in your life



## Reserve flowers in 3 easy steps:

1. Write your name on the flower reservation sign-up calendar on the bulletin board in the hallway. (Choosing the high or family altar or both altars)
2. Fill out a reservation card including your name, date, and how you would like your commemoration printed in the worship bulletin. Drop the card in the box outside the parish office. In order to be listed in the bulletin, the card needs to be turned in to the parish office no later than Tuesday before the Sunday service.
3. Contact your desired florist and purchase vases for the altar. (Note: each altar has 2 vases, so you will be placing an order for at least 2 vases). Have the flowers you ordered delivered to the church on Saturday morning between 9 am and 10 am.



## Liturgical Seasons - Colors on the Altar:

- **Easter Season** - White
- **Pentecost Sunday** - Red
- **Season after Pentecost and Epiphany** - Green
- **Palm Sunday** - Altar Guild provides the flowers
- **Saturday Easter Vigil** - Altar Guild provides the flowers

*No flowers are placed on the altars during Advent or Lent, with the exception of Rose Sunday, the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Lent.*

**There are 7 major feasts on the church calendar - Flowers should be reserved in appropriate colors. See suggestions below.**

**Easter Sunday** - Altar guild provides flowers (Lilies for the church)

**Ascension Thursday** - cornflower blue, ivy, white roses, wheat or bamboo

**Day of Pentecost** - red spikey flowers

**Trinity Sunday** - all white flowers with a few greens

**All Saints Sunday** – a suggestion would be wheat and any fall colored flowers

**Christmas Day, Christmas Season, and Epiphany Day** - Altar Guild provides flowers
