ALL CHURCHES IN THE DIOCESE OF EASTON CLOSED THROUGH MAY 10

The Bishop of Easton, the Rt. Rev Santosh Marray, has ordered all churches in the Diocese of Easton closed to in-person worship through May 10, to comply with the CDC recommendation of no large gatherings for the next eight weeks. Not since the Influenza epidemic of 1918 has such an action happened across the Episcopal Church.

At St Peter's in place of coming to church we will have livestream worship of Holy Eucharist for every Sunday through May 10 at 10am, and also livestreaming of the Wednesday noon Healing service. All are encouraged to tune into the livestreams, or watch the recording of the service later. Worship bulletins will be available in advance so that parishioners can follow the service.

The Well gathering will meet virtually Sunday's at 11:15am (see article below). All Daily Prayer is suspended until further notice, as is Sunday School and Youth Group meetings at the church facilities.

During this time St. Peter's is also holding all committee meetings and ministry group meetings via conference call or Zoom conferencing. Contact the Parish Office and staff can help to make arrangements to meet this way.

Other changes:

- No **weddings** will be scheduled at St. Peter's within the next six months.
- **Funerals** may take place during this time, but only the immediate family will be allowed in the church with the option to livestream the service for others.
- The April 26 **Annual Meeting** has been postponed
- St. Peter's facilities are now **closed to all outside groups** for meetings and events until further notice.
- The **Parish Office will remain open** regular hours Monday-Thursday 9-4 and Friday 9-2. The staff is here to serve you. Those conducting business are urged to contact staff by phone, email, mail or other remote means. Those who are sick or have been in contact with individuals who have the coronavirus will not be admitted to the Parish Office.
- St. Peter's is setting up **Shepherding Groups to facilitate regular communication with parishioners.** We are seeking shepherd volunteers who would be responsible for calling a dozen parish households each week to check in on parishioners. How about you? If you would volunteer to be a shepherd, please contact Rev. Adele at revadelehatfield@gmail.com – we are doing a shepherd orientation Monday at 530pm.
- We are seeking volunteers to help with delivering meals and transporting items to homebound parishioners and those in need. Contact Rev. Adele if you can help.
- The Eucharistic Visitor ministry is suspended. Only critical pastoral visits will be undertaken, supplemented with regular phone and video calls to parishioners needing pastoral care.
