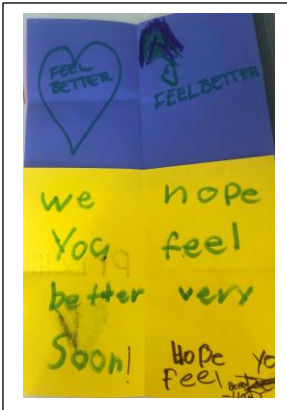


Pastoral Care at St. Peter's offers the love of God in many ways!

Here is a list of the components of Pastoral Care at St. Peter's:

- Lay Eucharistic Visitor Teams which take communion to the homebound
- Transportation Team provides rides to church services and events
- Greeting Card Ministry sends birthday & anniversary cards, cards of cheer and sympathy
- Meals for those in need
- Grief Ministry booklets sent to families experiencing a death
- Heart and Hands Knitting/Crocheting Ministry provides prayer shawls, baby blankets, hats for the homeless, knitted baskets for high school graduates
- New Baby Ministry celebrates with families expecting a child
- Shepherding Groups keep people connected with the Church through phone/email communications during the Pandemic
