HOW CAN I HELP?

Talk to your kids. Lock up prescription medications. Dispose of any expired or unwanted medications at one of the ten locations in Wicomico County. Share our educational messages. Get trained to administer Narcan.

GOOD SAMARITAN LAW

Educate yourself and your kids on Maryland's Good Samaritan Law, which protects those who call 911 when someone has overdosed. Save a life...Call 911!

GET NARCAN TRAINED

Narcan is a life-saving prescription drug that reverses the effects of an opioid overdose. Call the Wicomico County Health Department to learn more about FREE trainings at 410-543-6981.

Maryland has a standing order for Narcan, which means you no longer need a prescription for this medication. Contact your local pharmacy for details.
