BISHOP DIRECTS CHURCHES TO RE-OPEN FOR IN-PERSON WORSHIP The Bishop of Eastern announced that he is ending suspension of in-person worship in churches in the Diocese. He is limiting the number of people who can be in the congregation to what the Governor of Maryland's latest directive on indoor gatherings limit is: currently 10 people or fewer. This is in addition to the ministers, musicians, ushers, altar guild members and other ministers that support the service.

The shelter is in need of meals and people to check folks in and be there in the early evening. St. Peter's has agreed to take the week of **Sat. Jan 16 through Friday Jan 23**. Parishioner Scott Mahler is keeping track of volunteer signups – please contact him to find out what needs there are and to sign up for a night or two: this is also a great opportunity for a ministry group of a small group of parishioners to get together (socially distancing of course) and make a meal or help sign people in and help out. 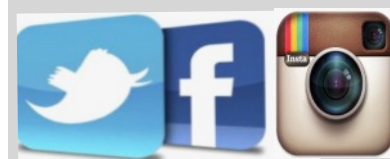
