DEACON LYNN CONCLUDES HER SERVICE APRIL 27; ORDINATION SCHEDULED MAY 17 Deacon Lynn Wiljanen concludes her year of service as our Deacon at the end of this month. Her last Sunday with us is April 27. We will say farewell to her at the service and there will be a coffee hour reception in her honor. Plan to attend to wish her well and thank her for her service to us at St. Peter's.

Deacon Lynn is serving as a transitional deacon. That means that she is serving as deacon before she can be ordained a priest in the church. Bishop Santosh Marray has announced that she will be ordained to the Sacred Order of Priests at St. Paul's, Marion Station, on May 17; she will then be serving as a curate in that parish. Because of the small size of St. Paul's attendance at her ordination will be by invitation only. However, we can all pray for her as she prepares for her ordination as priest in the Episcopal Church. At this time, there are no plans for St. Peter's to be assigned a new Deacon to serve in the parish.
