She has performed at festivals including the XV Latvian Song and Dance Festival in Toronto and the 37th International Organ Music Festival at Riga Cathedral, and has collaborated with the Grammy-winning Pacific Boychoir Academy.

Deeply connected to her Latvian heritage,

liturgical music, and organizes concerts and
special events, bringing excellence and cultural
richness to worship and the wider community.
