**RECTOR TO GO ON SABBATICAL THIS SUMMER** Father David Michaud will be on sabbatical this summer from June 15 through August 20. In his letter of agreement with the parish, Father David is entitled to a sabbatical every five years; as of May he will have served 14 years at St. Peter's and has taken only one other sabbatical in 2022. For this sabbatical Father David will be visiting the American West in his camper with his spouse, Kelli, experiencing many National Parks in the interior and West Coast. During his time away Pastor Greg with assistance from Deacon Laura will be directing St. Peter's ministries and operations.

The Vestry has set up a Sabbatical Fund to help raise the funds necessary to fund the sabbatical, both for Father David and the parish. Father David has pledged to provide more than \$6,000 toward the sabbatical and has secured a \$6,000 grant for the diocese. The parish needs to raise the remaining funds. Members can make a contribution to the Sabbatical Fund by writing a check to St. Peter's with "Sabbatical Fund" on the memo line, or by going on-line to make a contribution.
