SUMMER LITURGIES We are now in the Season after Pentecost. With the choir in recess this summer, we will be relying on more congregational singing at our Sunday services. The hymn of praise at the 10:30am service this summer is Canticle 13: Glory to You, Lord God of our Fathers. We will be using Eucharistic Prayer A for Rite II Holy Eucharist at both services. Our Music Director and Organist Lauma Akmene will be taking some summer Sundays off and guest organist Richard Strattan will be filling in. We will continue to livestream both the 8:30am and 10:30am services. For the Fourth of July weekend Bishop Shand and the Standing Committee of the Diocese of Easton are asking parishes to use the Independence Day lectures for July 5. Save the date for Green Hill Sunday: August 23-- 10am worship service with a picnic to follow. This Green Hill Sunday Father David will preside and the Rev. Shiela McJilton, Interim Rector at St. Alban's, will preach. We move to our fall liturgies when the choir returns on September 13.

PASTOR GREG AND DEACON LAURA TAKE ON ADDITIONAL DUTIES THIS SUMMER

Father David's sabbatical begins June 15 and his last Sunday will be June 14. He returns from sabbatical on Sunday, August 23. During his sabbatical the Vestry has approved having Pastor Greg take on most of Father David's responsibilities and increasing him to be a full time Assistant Rector while Father David is away. Pastor Greg will assume sacramental and most administrative duties of the Rector so if you contacted Father David about particular issues then while he is away contact Pastor Greg.

In addition, Deacon Laura will be working Tuesdays as parish communications coordinator and will be producing the weekly Peter's Post and other communications, as well as maintaining the parish website.

The Vestry has moved its June and August meetings so that they are before and after Father David's sabbatical, now scheduled for June 10 and August 26. The Vestry does not usually meet in July.

BUILDING SURVEILLANCE SECURITY SYSTEM UPGRADED Last month St. Peter's security systems were upgraded and some nonfunctioning monitors replaced. Now the camera monitors for the kitchen/parish hall and the choir room are functioning and people can now unlock the door by the parking lot from those locations. Those using the library room also can unlock that door near the monitor.
